### Supplies & Instructions

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## Supplies

1 Red T-Shirt

3 Sheets of orange felt (8 1/2 x 11 in.)

1 Sheet of tan craft foam (12 x 18 in.)

1 Sheet of brown craft foam (12 x 18 in.)

1 Sheet of computer paper

Elastic

Thick string or cording

Craft Scissors

All-purpose craft glue

Fabric glue (If your all-purpose craft glue is not safe on fabric, use fabric glue on the t-shirt)

Stapler

Hole Punch

Measuring Tape

Pen

Pencil

Black Sharpie

All supplies can be found and purchased at a craft store, such as Michaels.

Joe Logo

Joe the Monkey Mask

Right Foot & Left Foot Patterns

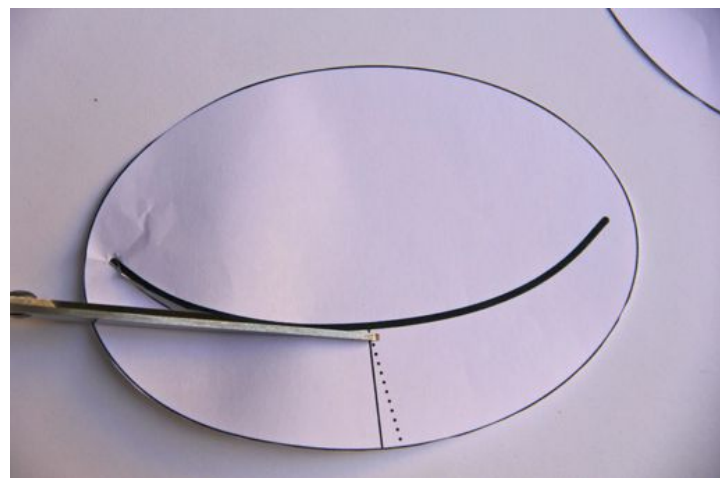
Sleeve Pattern (See instructions below)

## Sleeve Pattern Instructions

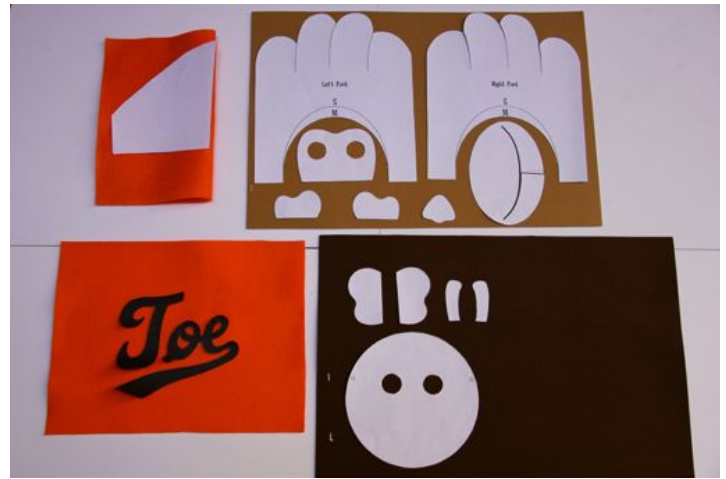
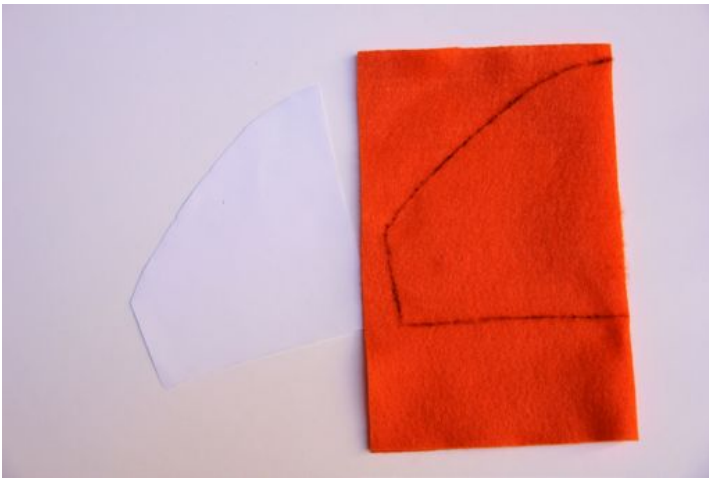


1. Lay the shirt's sleeve over a piece of plain computer paper and trace around the three straight sides of the sleeve.
2. Fold back the shirt and connect the ends of your lines with a curved line.
3. Cut out your patterns.

## Cutting Instructions



1. Cut out all patterns, being sure to cut out the eye holes on the face and head, cut a slit over the smile line on the mouth and cut down the lines between the toes on the foot patterns. Cut the appropriate size for the foot patterns. **Note:** The medium size was based on a size 12 shoe.



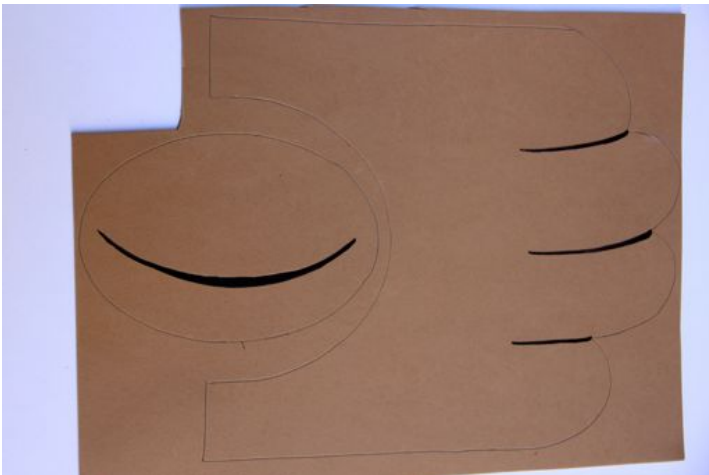
2. Lay out patterns as follows and trace.

On the orange felt: Joe logo, sleeve pattern (Cut 2, see below)

To cut the sleeve: **Fold one sheet of felt in half, lay the longest straight line (shoulder) along the fold. Repeat for second sleeve.**

On the tan craft foam: left shoe pattern, right shoe pattern, face, inner ears, mouth, nose

On the brown craft foam: head, outer ears, antennae



3. Before you cut, use your black sharpie to trace over the smile line on the mouth and trace the lines between the toes. You will NOT cut these lines.

4. Cut out all pattern pieces and you're ready to make your costume!

# T-Shirt Instructions



1. Using a thin layer of your fabric-safe glue, glue the “Joe” pattern pieces to the center of your t-shirt, on a slight angle.

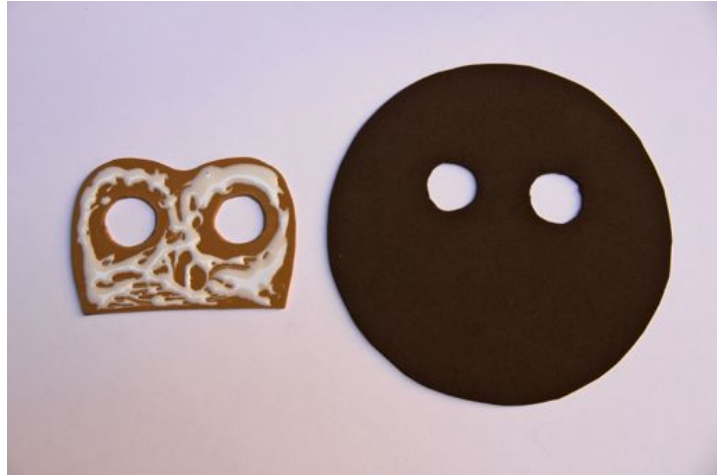


2. Apply a thin layer of glue to one of your sleeve patterns. Carefully wrap the pattern around the sleeve, matching the curved line of your pattern with the sleeve’s seam. Smooth over the felt with your hands, ensuring there are no creases in the felt. Repeat with second sleeve.



3. Allow to dry. You may want to hang the shirt on a padded hanger to prevent a crease from forming on the shoulder. Once dry, trim any excess felt off the edge of the sleeve.

# Mask Instructions



1. Using your all-purpose craft glue, glue the face piece to the head, matching up eye cut-outs.



2. Glue inner ears onto outer ears. Then glue ears to the sides of the head.

3. Glue antennae to the top of the head. Glue the mouth to the head. Glue the nose on top of the mouth.



4. Allow to dry.

5. Using a hole punch, cut holes on each the side of the head, slightly above the ears. Slip string through the holes leaving the ends long enough to fit and tie around child's head.

# Shoe Cover Instructions



1. Cut two pieces of elastic, each approximately 2 1/2 in. long.
2. Wrap your left shoe pattern around the intended shoe. Lightly mark the foot arch of the shoe on each side of the pattern. Repeat with right shoe. Note: If you notice excess foam extending past the shoe's sides, trim this off.



3. Using a stapler, securely attach elastic to the pattern at each mark you made.



4. Carefully slip over shoes, securing elastic under the arch of each shoe.

# The Finished Costume!



To complete the costume, wear it with brown leggings or long underwear and khaki shorts!

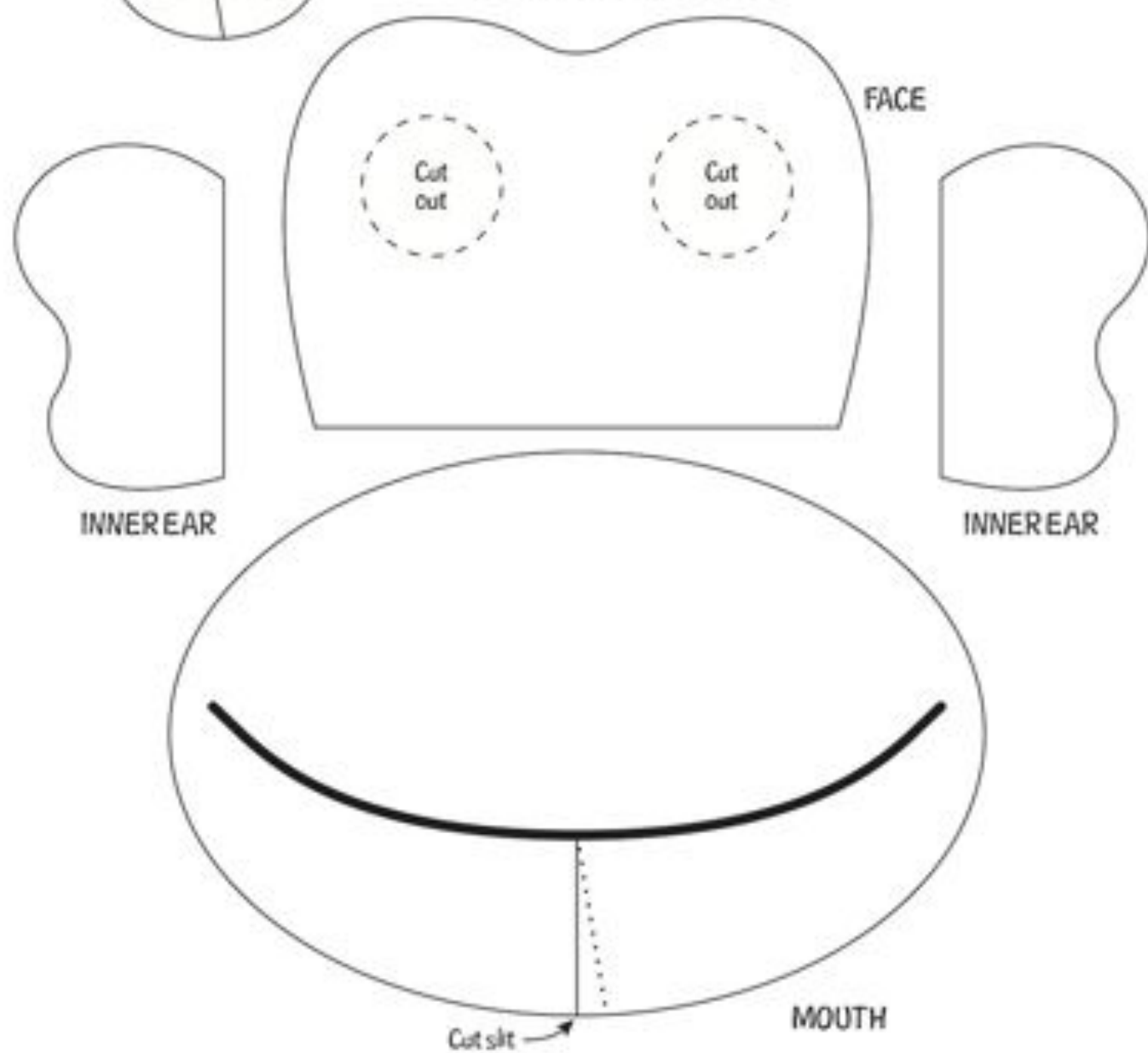

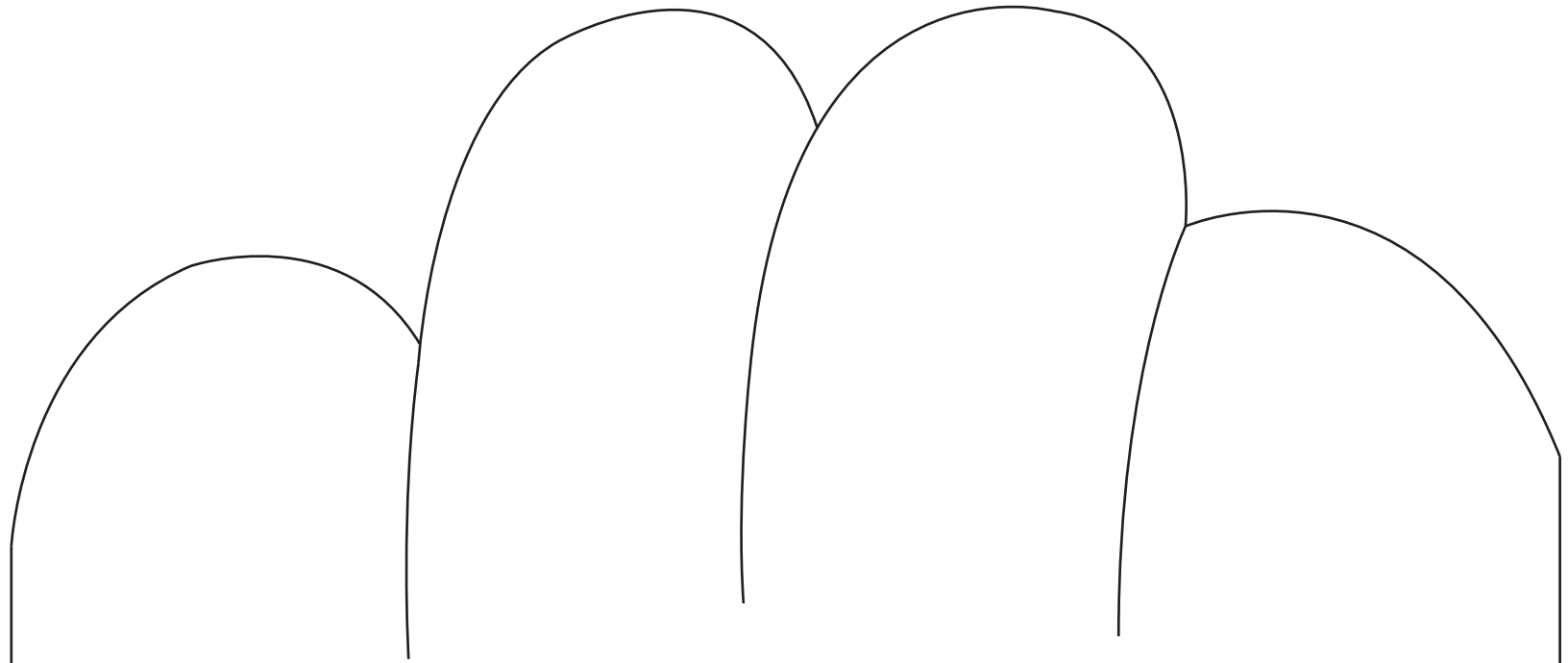
